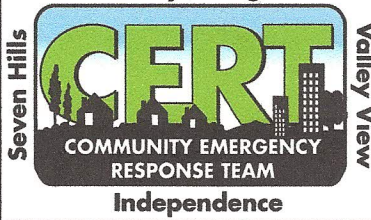

Hello and Happy Spring!

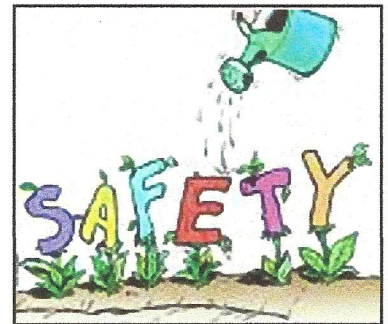
I can't believe how good all the lawn mowers sounded a few days ago when the rain stopped and the sun came out! Spring is finally here!
